



## Statistician

**Number of Posts: 1**

**Contract Type:** Full Time, Indefinite

### Job description:

The National Statistics Office (NSO) of Malta is looking for aspiring and talented individuals to join their team in the position of Statistician on a full-time indefinite basis. The incumbents will be assigned to horizontal or technical units according to their area of specialisation and the exigencies of the institution.

This position is an excellent career opportunity for prospective candidates with an academic background in Statistics, Mathematics and/or Economics.

Besides an excellent level of interpersonal and communication skills, successful candidates must have sound numerical and analytical skills.

### Responsibilities:

The duties of a Statistician include:

- a) Designing methods and procedures for obtaining data, such as surveys and administrative sources;
- b) Contributing to the development of innovative data collection and analytical tools;
- c) Verifying data for inaccuracies and applying statistical methods to address such limitations;
- d) Analysing data in economic, business and social fields, in both aggregate and raw form;
- e) Contributing to the writing of reports and the preparation of data for publication;
- f) Helping to build confidence in statistics using the guidelines of the National Statistics Office and the principles of the European Statistics Code of Practice;
- g) Identifying client needs and presenting findings;
- h) Interpreting statistical analysis for policy development;
- i) Participating in and contributing to research;
- j) Following and taking part in national and international statistical fora;
- k) Carrying out ancillary duties as may be assigned by superiors.

A detailed job description can be obtained from the Head of Unit - Human Resources and Staff Development, at the NSO.

### Requirements :

Applicants for this post must:

- Be in possession of a recognised Certificate at MQF Level 6 or higher in a relevant subject area;
- Demonstrate a good command of the English language, together with Maltese or another official European language.

Prospective applicants should note the requirement to produce MQRIC recognition statements in respect of their qualifications from MQRIC, or other designated authorities, as applicable, as per provisions applicable to this call for applications. Candidates who have not yet formally obtained the qualifications specified above will still be considered, provided that they submit evidence that they are in the final phase of their course leading to such qualifications.



**Training provided:** NSO employees are provided one-to-one on job training, mentorship, and technical training on software. Other training initiatives include yearly Information Security tuition, Public Service training programmes, European Statistical Training Programmes, and tailor-made training programmes.

**Others benefits:**

The NSO strives to offer:

- A friendly working environment;
- Teleworking, family friendly measures and a work-life balance;
- Health insurance cover;
- Flexible working arrangements and;
- Training and opportunities for pursuing further studies including scholarships.

**Salary :** The position carries a starting remuneration of €26,969 for the year 2022, which remuneration increases annually subject to provisions of the Collective Agreement 2017-2022. This remuneration excludes qualification allowances and any overtime pay, which are reimbursed separately on an ad hoc basis, as need arises

**How will the interviews be held? :** All applications received will be acknowledged. Thereafter, shortlisted candidates will be invited for an interview of approximately 60 minutes. Interviews are generally held in the Maltese or English languages. Present at the interview are usually 3 members of the interviewing board, plus an HR member acting as rapporteur.

Interviews include a discussion about the role, the candidates' knowledge and competence related to the role, in certain cases an improvisational test scenario related to the role, and an assessment of the candidates' background and experiences as conveyed within their CV.
